<b>Reign</b>	goods transported in bulk by truck, train, ship, or aircraft. "a decline in the amount of freight carried by rail"
<b>Sleigh</b>	a person living next door to or very near to the speaker or person referred to. "our garden was the envy of the neighbours"
<b>Reins</b>	a sledge drawn by horses or reindeer, especially one used for passengers.
<b>Freight</b>	hold royal office; rule as monarch. "Queen Elizabeth <b>reigns over</b> the UK"
<b>Neighbour</b>	a long, narrow strap attached at one end to a horse's bit, typically used in pairs to guide or check a horse in riding or driving.
